- You are responsible for preparing the development tools to be used with this product.
- Only within 30 days of shipment from our company, the product will be replaced if the product is in normal use according to the contents of this product manual or instruction manual, and if there is a problem or failure clearly caused by a manufacturing defect. The determination of a manufacturing defect is at the discretion of our company.
- We do not handle to repair requests. We also do not report the analysis results of the cause of the failure.
- We will not replace the product in the case of failure or damage caused by intentional negligence by the customer or equipment other than the product.
- We will not replace the product in the case of failure or damage caused by errata of parts manufacturer installed in the product.
- Our company shall not be liable for any direct or secondary damage to data stored on your equipment, etc. resulting from the failure of this product or the use of this product.
